Overview

Opera Australia is seeking to cast the Children's Chorus for our upcoming production of *La bohème* as part of their 2025 Sydney Winter season. Gale Edwards' glittering production, set in the fairy light-filled cabarets of 1930s Berlin, is a long-time favourite of audiences.

La bohème will be performed at the **Sydney Opera House from 23 August to 20 September 2025,** and sung in Italian.

Performers must be available for the entire rehearsal period from 28 July (TBC) and performance period from 23 August.

To this end, we strongly encourage applications from performers of varied experiences, perspectives and circumstances including performers from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds and performers with disabilities. All ethnicities are encouraged to submit an application.

Child Performers x 12 (any gender)

Age: 10-15 years old

Height: No taller than 155cm tall

Range: Treble range

Children must live within 90-minutes travel (one way) of both venues.

Audition Information

Audition applications will be accepted via the following web form only: Webform

You will need to include a **short one-minute video** of your child singing.

- Please choose a classical or musical theatre piece, it does not need to be the entire piece.
- The video does not need to be of professional quality or high production value. Please check the recording before uploading that it is clear and audible.
- We should be able to hear your child clearly singing, without them using a microphone or amplification.
- Musical accompaniment, backing track or singing acapella (without accompaniment) is fine to use.
- You will be able to upload the video, or include a link. Please ensure we are able to access any links.

Please also include:

- Current CV (in PDF format)
- Headshot (this does not need to be a professional photo)

If successful, I an audition will be offered. Auditions will be held from **10:30am on Monday 5 May, 2025 at the Opera Centre, 480 Elizabth Street, Surry Hills, NSW.** They must be accompanied by an adult to their audition.

Everyone will be notified of the outcome of your child's application, once applications have closed.

Children auditioning will be asked to bring and perform a short solo from classical repertoire or musical theatre repertoire. They may be asked to learn a short section of music, or work on some aural skills.
