TO NOTE:

- All applicants must ordinarily reside within 60 minutes travel to The Regent Theatre, Melbourne
 - **Evidence of address will need to be shown at auditions regarding travel time, please use google maps as a refer
- Height restriction is 145cm
- All children will need to be 10 years old by 17 November 2025
- Parts of the audition process may be filmed for casting, marketing and publicity purposes. Should any filming for publicity or marketing take place, auditionees will be informed in advance and will be given the opportunity to either opt in or out of filming as they wish via a release form. The auditionee acknowledges that filming may take place and no payment shall be received.
- The auditionee acknowledges that attendance at an audition is at their own risk. Any costs incurred in attending an audition are the sole responsibility of the auditionee and not the Producer.
- It is a condition of employment that any cast member interacting with the children attain a *Working With Children Check* prior to rehearsals commencing.

AUDITION PREPARATION

If you are auditioning for Little Anastasia/Alexei Romanov:

- Please prepare the relevant show material linked in the audition pack below.
- Please also prepare at least one own song (16 bars) in the style of the show that demonstrates your vocal range. Please bring sheet music with you in the correct key, presented in a folder or bound document (no loose-leaf sheets).
- You may be required to do a dance audition. This will be a very simple combination, taught on the day in a separate dance audition.

What to bring to your audition:

- CV
- Headshot
- Sheet music for accompanist. No backing tracks.
- For the dance call, please wear appropriate dance wear including ballet shoes if you have them.

AUDITION STRUCTURE

All applicants will be required to sing first, likely in groups of 10. They may be invited to remain for a dance and scene work audition on the same day, so please arrive prepared and please allow extra time. CHARACTER BREAKDOWN

CHILD - LITTLE ANASTASIA/ALEXEI ROMANOV (Female presenting, playing age 7-9)

The willful, brave, and sweet youngest daughter of the Tsar of Russia. She's heartbroken that her grandmother, the Dowager, is leaving Russia.

Doubles as the son and heir of the Tsar, a high-spirited boy afflicted with hemophilia.

Strong movement ability; beautiful soprano voice.

Height limit: 145cm

The children cast as Little Anastasia will be called upon to sing and dance in a number of scenes. Throughout rehearsals, they will work under the guidance of the Director, Music Director and Choreographer and their assistants, to be trained and taught all artistic aspects and expectations that their role requires. During the rehearsal period, the production team will expect them to work within schedules and parameters created and issued by them. They will interact and rehearse with the entire adult cast.
