German-born conductor Erina Yashima will make her Opera Australia debut to lead the Opera Australia Orchestra followed by OA's Chorus Master Paul Fitzsimon later in the season.

With its glorious music and universal themes of love, friendship and loss, *La Bohème* is a story that transcends time and place, making it enticing for opera fans and easily accessible for newcomers, providing a wonderful opportunity to showcase the beauty of opera to all.
